Rules & Routines

Rules and routines in classroom helps students:

- engage more successfully in activities and prevents problem behavior
- learn greater responsibility and self-management

Establishing rules: establish a behaviour management approach, linked to the shared school values

Teaching rules: stating rules in clearly and what is expected from them

Support: Providing support to students according to their individual needs, culture, etc. and adjusting as necessary, in ways students can understand and achieve

Evaluation: evaluating the effectiveness of the rules and making changes if nescecarry

Understanding the Behaviour

01

- Identify the root cause
 - Patient centred practise
 - Establish good communication
 - Seek assistance if required
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Clear Instructions & Positive Language

02

- Setting limits using a calm and respectful manner
 - Ensure safety for both students and staff

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Learning Environment

By increasing students' engagement in learning, behavioural problems are less likely to arise.

Safety and Wellbeing: When students know they are supported, respected and valued, they are more likely to open themselves up to challenges

Building positive relationships: the quality of teacher-student relationships is the keystone for all aspects of classroom management.

Differentiation: All students learn differently, come from different cultures, and with different needs. By creating an inclusive classroom, students are given learning opportunities with a better chance of engagement and success.
